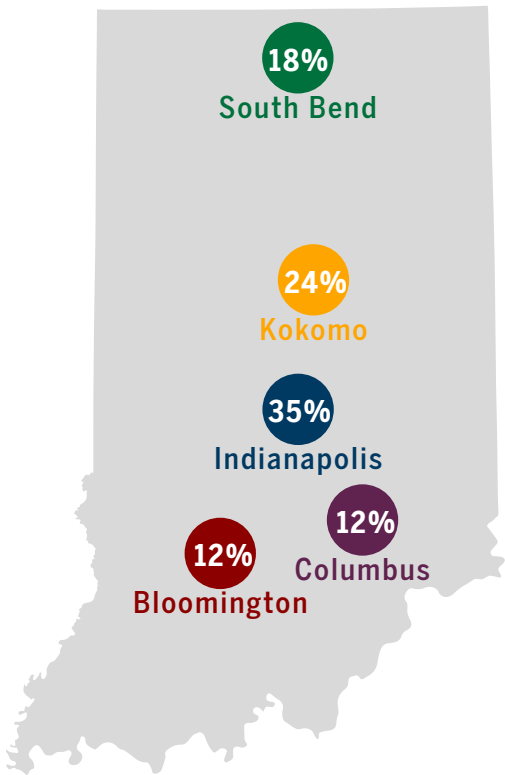


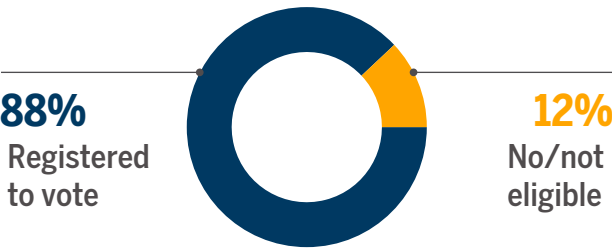
Gubernatorial student interest survey insights

Respondents voter registration status



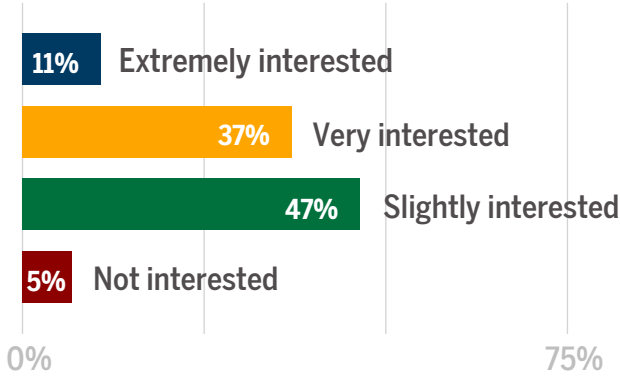
Policy topic ranking

Students were asked to rank the PPI Gubernatorial Forum topics in order from most to least important. Based upon all student responses, this is how each topic ranked.

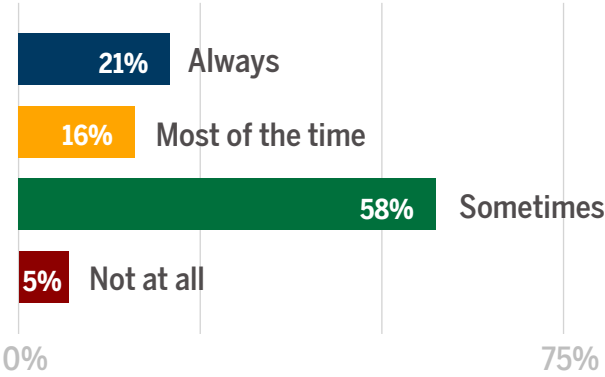


Interest in Indiana politics

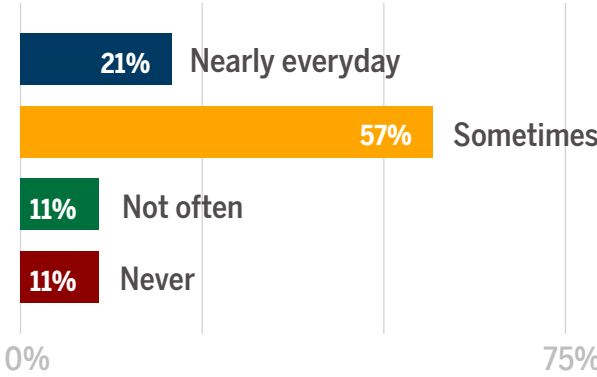
How interested would you say you are in Indiana state-level politics?



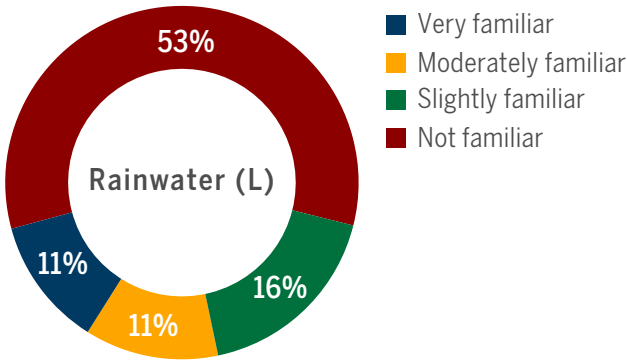
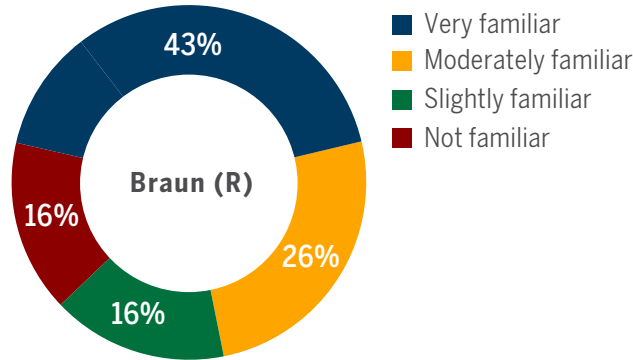
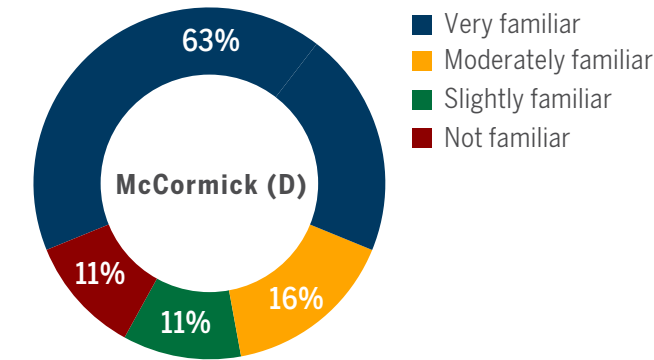
How often would you say you follow current events in state government and public affairs?
